On Approving the Regulations on Numbering Plan Administration and Management

Given the need to adjust the Regulations on National Numbering Plan Administration and Management to the Law on Electronic Communications no.241-XVI of 15.11.2007, to simplify the procedure of assigning numbering resources, to implement numbering resources for new services, etc.,

Based on:

Art.9, (1)h of Law on Electronic Communications no.241-XVI of 15.11.2007, National Numbering Plan approved by Order of Ministry of Transport and Communications, no.72 of 08.04.2003,

The Administrative Board hereby D E C I D E S:

1. To approve the Regulations on Numbering Plan Administration and Management according to Annex.

2. This decision shall enter in force on the date it is published in the Official Gazette of the Republic of Moldova”.

REGULATIONS ON NATIONAL NUMBERING PLAN ADMINISTRATION AND MANAGEMENT

1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. The Regulations on Numbering Plan Administration and Management (hereinafter – the Regulations) set forth the rules for the administration of telephone numbering resources, the procedures for their primary assignment, reservation, withdrawal, renewal and control of utilization, conditions of ensuring the access to numbering resources within electronic communications networks.
2. The Regulations is aimed at ensuring efficient management of numbering resources, consistently with the principles of objectivity, proportionality transparency and non-discriminatory access to these resources.
3. The National Regulatory Agency for Electronic Communications and Information Technology (hereinafter – the Agency) is empowered to administrate and assign numbering resources pursuant to the provisions of Law on Electronic Communications no.241 – XVI of 15.11.2007, National numbering Plan of the Republic of Moldova (hereinafter – the NNP) and these Regulations.
4. The use of numbering resources from the NNP without a License for the Use of Numbering Resources or a Decision on Numbering Resources Assignment, issued by the Agency, shall be forbidden. The breach of this provision shall be sanctioned pursuant to the legislation in force.
5. The numbers assigned by the Agency to providers of public electronic communications networks and services shall be re-assigned to their subscribers in the format prescribed by the NNP and the Regulations.

2. DEFINITIONS

For the purpose of these Regulations, the terms below shall mean the following:

Numbering Resources – any numbers, codes, names or addresses, serving for identification of subscribers, providers of electronic communications networks and/or services.

Number Range – a set of consecutive numbers with a common first digit.

Number Block – succession of numbers in a particular consecutive order used for operation of an electronic communications network or for the provision of electronic communications services.

Accesss Code – one or more digits at the beginning of a number, which identifies the type of network and/or service.

Geographic Number – a number from the NNP, in the structure of which a part of the digits carry geographical significance and are used to route the calls to the physical location of the network termination point.

Non-geographic Number - a number from NNP which is non-geographic. A non-geographic number includes, inter alia, mobile telephone numbers, Freephone numbers, Premium Rate numbers, etc.

Reservation - a decision confirming that particular numbering resources are reserved for a particular electronic communications provider for a specified timeframe for the purpose of being subsequently allocated.

Primary assignment – a decision stating the right of an electronic communications provider to use the assigned resources for his own needs (e.g. testing, routing, etc.) and for the needs of his subscribers.

Secondary assignment - an assignment of a number or a block of numbers by a provider to his subscribers, from the numbering resources assigned to him by the agency, where r contractual terms and conditions.

The terms where fined in these Regulations shall bear the meaning given by the Law on Electronic Communications.

3. ADMINISTRATION OF NUMBERING RESOURCES

1. The numbering resources shall be administered by the Agency. The Agency Director shall issue the Order designating the Administrator of Numbering Resources (hereinafter – the Administrator), conferring him the following powers:

- a) To process the applications requesting licenses for the use of numbering resources and the documents attached thereto;
- b) To complete license forms and explanatory notes regarding assigned numbers and submit them to the Agency Director’s approval;
- c) To keep license copies;
- d) Compile and keep dossiers of applicants for numbering resources;
- e) Offer consultations to applicant for numbering resources;
- f) Carry on correspondence with the applicants for numbering resources and holders of such licenses;
- g) Keep the “Register of Numbering Resources”.

2. The processing of applications for numbering resources shall be objective, transparent, proportionate and non discriminatory in relation to access to numbering resources and shall take into account the following factors:

- a) Correspondence of the required numbering resources to the NNP and the requirements of the Regulations;
- b) Necessity for numbering resources;
- c) Service nature;
- d) Applicant’s market position;
- e) Efficient use of numbering resources;
- f) Ensuring reserves of free numbering resources for the subsequent development of public electronic communications networks and services and competition promotion;
- g) Geographical location, if appropriate.

4. LICENSES FOR USE OF NUMBERING RESOURCES

4.1 General License Issuance Procedures

1. The provider of public electronic communications networks and/or services applying for licenses for the use of numbering resources shall submit the following documents to the Agency;

- a. Application for license issuance, according to Annex 1;
- b. If appropriate, the report regarding the use of the previously assigned numbering resources;
- c. If appropriate, a explanatory note justifying the need for the numbering resources requested, manner and conditions of their use.

2. The written application, in the form provided in Annex 1, together with the documents necessary for license issuance, shall be submitted personally or by a representative at the Agency office or sent via registered mail, with acknowledgment of receipt.

3. The application shall be registered in the “Register of Applications and Licenses for Use of Numbering Resources”, showing the date of receipt, whereas the Administrator shall lodge the documents, submitted by the applicant, in a dossier, to which subsequently will be added:

- a copy of the license for the use of numbering resources; or
- a letter of refusal to issue a license;

4. The license for use of numbering resources or the letter of refusal to issue such a license shall be delivered to the applicant in maximum 15 calendar days from date the application was registered. The letter of refusal must be justified. The term for decision whether to issue the license or to refuse it shall be valid for all types of numbering resources, except those provided in section 6 of this Chapter.

5. The license for the use of numbering resources shall be issued for every type of numbering resources or, if appropriate, for every number block.
 6. When licenses for use of numbering resources are issued through a bidding process, the term for processing an application shall not exceed 6 weeks.
 7. After a decision is taken to issue a license for the use of numbering resources, a notification to that effect shall be handed in to the applicant, informing him of the decision, together with a bill for the assigned or reserved numbering resources, payable in accordance with the tariffs in force. The bill shall be paid within 30 calendar days from the date it was issued by the Agency.
 8. Licenses for the use of numbering resources shall be issued on standard forms, approved according to an established procedure, supplemented with the conditions for the use of the numbering resources in question. Licenses shall be signed by the Agency Director or person in charge and authenticated by Agency stamp.
 9. Licenses for the use of numbering resources shall be registered in the “Register of Applications and Licenses for Use of Numbering Resources”, the original license being handed in to the applicant, whereas the copy being lodged in the dossier by the Administrator.
 10. The validity terms of licenses for use of numbering resources shall be 10 years from the issuance date (including the period for which the license was suspended), except:
 - a) Licenses for the use of numbering resources, issued to holders of licenses for the use of radio frequencies and channels where their number is limited, for which the validity term shall be 15 years;
 - b) Licenses requested for terms shorter than 10 years.
 11. The Agency shall have the right to refuse to issue a license for the use of numbering resources in the following cases:
 - a) the numbering resources requested by the providers are not available for assignment, as they have already been assigned or are intended for other services, according to the NNP;
 - b) the applicant is not authorized within the general authorization regime for public electronic communications networks or services, which require the use of the numbering resources requested;
 - c) the previously assigned numbering resources are not efficiently used;
 - d) the previously assigned numbering resources were used for purposes other than the ones specified in the license for the use of numbering resources;
 - e) the requested assignment will restrict competition;
 12. Licenses for the use of numbering resources, including their copies and duplicates, their modification and update shall be free of charge.
- #### 4.2. Licenses for Use of Numbering Resources for Testing
1. Licenses for the use of numbering resources in testing public electronic communications networks and services shall be assigned to providers of public electronic communications networks and services, authorized within the general authorization regime for the provision of public electronic communications networks and services.
 2. The provider of public electronic communications networks and services, requesting numbering resources for testing, shall undergo the General Procedure of license issuance for the use of numbering resources.
 3. The license for the use of numbering resources shall be marked with "For Testing Purposes".
 4. The term for issuing licenses for the use of numbering resources in testing electronic communications networks shall be set for every separate case.
 5. No license holder authorized for the use of numbering resources marked with "For Testing Purposes" shall have the right to hand it over to a third party.
- #### 4.3 Updating Licenses for Use of Numbering Resources
1. The modification of the License holder’s name and legal address shall be considered as grounds for license update.

2. Where there is need for license update, the license holder, within 10 working days, shall submit an application to that effect to the Agency, present the original of the license to be updated and the excerpt from the State Register of Enterprises and Organizations.

3. The Agency, within 15 calendar days from the date the application and related documents was submitted, shall issue the license for the use of numbering resources, updated on a new form, taking into account the modifications indicated in the application, without modifying the term of initial numbering resources assignment, indicated in the license.

4.4 Modification of Licenses for Use on Numbering Resources

1. The Agency shall have the right to modify previously issued licenses for the use of numbering resources, in case if:

- a) modifications are made to the NNP, to the legal framework governing the electronic communications sector and the Regulations;
- b) another number block or other numbering resources similar to previous are assigned;
- c) a part of the previously assigned numbering resources is withdrawn.

4.5 Suspension and Withdrawal of Licenses for Use of Numbering Resources

1. The right to use numbering resources can be suspended, where the license holder admitted non-compliance with the decision on eliminating breaches, with the obligations prescribed by normative acts, license conditions, after legal actions have been taken such as warning or fining.

2. The right conferred through the license for the use of numbering resources can be withdrawn if:

- a) the license holder has applied for license withdrawal;
- b) the license holder failed to remove, in the prescribed term, the circumstances conducive to the suspension of the license for the use of numbering resources.

3. Licenses shall become invalid if:

- a) the provider of public electronic communications networks and/or services was deprived of the right to provide such services;
- b) the applicant is unable to present the document confirming the payment of the appropriate fees, within 30 working days from the date he was notified about the decision to issue him a license;
- c) the license is withdrawn;
- d) the provider of public electronic communications networks and/or services is liquidated;
- e) a new license is issued to the license holder, to replace the previous one, this becoming invalid on the date the new license comes into force.

4. The Agency shall suspend or withdraw the license for the use of numbering resources, with subsequent appeal to court, within 3 working days. In case of non-compliance with this term the suspension or withdrawal shall be cancelled.

5. License holders, whose license for the use of numbering resources for a certain service or network is withdrawn, shall not have the right to benefit from licenses for the use of numbering resources for such networks or services for a timeframe from 3 to 12 months from the date of withdrawal.

4.6 Renewal of Licenses for Use of Numbering Resources

1. The holder of a license can apply for a new assignment of the numbering resources, previously held. For this purpose he shall submit an application 30 days before the expiry of the previous assignment and undergo the general procedure of license issuance for the use of numbering resources, as set forth in section 4.1.

2. On expiry, licenses for the use of numbering resources can be renewed for similar timeframes where r the law.

5. CONDITIONS FOR ASSIGNMENT OF NUMBERING RESOURCES

5.1 Assignment of Number Blocks to Providers of Public Fixed and Mobile Telephone Networks and Services

1. Block of numbers shall be assigned to providers of public fixed and mobile telephone networks and services pursuant to the general procedure of license issuance for the use of numbering resources and the corresponding conditions for assignment of the requested numbering resources.

2. After a decision on number block assignment has been adopted, the Administrator shall write out the bill and the provider shall pay for the use of numbering resources during the first year.
3. Payments for the following year shall be made before the expiry of 1 year from the previous payment.
4. Where at the end of the first year less than 6-% of the number blocks assigned for fixed and mobile telephony is used, such use shall be considered inefficient.
5. The assignment of the following number block shall be possible only provided that at least 60% of the previously assigned numbers are used.
6. The holder of a license for the use of numbering resources shall not have the right to hand over the assigned numbering resources to a third party. The numbers from the blocks assigned to providers of fixed and mobile networks and service providers shall be re-assigned to their subscribers.

5.1.1 Conditions for Assignment of Number Blocks to Providers of Public Fixed Telephone Networks and Services

1. Geographical numbers for fixed telephone networks shall be assigned to providers of public fixed telephone networks and services in the format ZA(B)yxxxx(x), where ZA(B) – are national destination codes (NDC), Z = 2; A = 2...9; B = 0...9; y = 2...9 and x = 0...9, in blocks of 100, 1000 or 10000 numbers.
2. Geographical numbers with the same national destination codes shall be used by terminal equipment physically located within the same numbering zone. The codes of the numbering zones from the Republic of Moldova shall be provided in the NNP and shall be obligatory for all electronic communications providers.
3. Geographical numbers for fixed telephone networks WLL (Wireless Local Loop) of the format ZA(B) qyxxx(x), where Z = 2; A = 2...9; B = 0...9; q = 9; y = 1...9 and x = 0...9 shall be assigned to providers of public fixed telephone networks and services in blocks of 100 or 1000 numbers.
4. Geographical numbers of the format ZA(B) yxxxx(x), where Z = 2; A = 2...9; B = 0...9; y = 8 and x = 0...9, shall be assigned to providers of public fixed telephone networks and services, except JSC „Moldtelecom”, in blocks of 100 or 1000 numbers.
5. Numbers independent of location shall be assigned from the number block „38XXXXXX”, where X = 0...9, for electronic communications services that use IP package-switched technologies (NGN), mainly provided at fixed locations, in 1000 or 10000 numbers. The numbers independent of location shall not be used for the provision of the services for which specific numbers are available.

5.1.2 Conditions for Assignment of Number Blocks to Providers of Public Mobile Telephone Networks and Service

1. Non-geographic numbers shall be assigned to providers of public mobile telephone networks and services from number ranges „6” and „7” in blocks of 10 000 or 100 000 numbers.

5.2 Assignment of Short Numbers and Accesss Codes to Public Electronic Communications Networks and Services from Range “1”

5.2.1 Conditions for Assignment of Accesss Codes from Range “1”

1. Accesss codes to public electronic communications networks and services shall be assigned de by the Agency to the providers, authorized to provide public electronic communications networks and services, in order to be used as accesss code for the provision of those networks and services.
2. A provider applying for accesss codes to public electronic communications networks and services, shall undergo the general procedure of license issuance for the use of numbering resources and follow the correspondng assignment conditions for the requested numbering resources.
3. Where several providers apply for the same accesss codes, the Agency shall adopt a decision based on casting lots.
4. The providers of public fixed and cell mobile networks and services shall ensure the accesss from their own and other networks and from different geographic zones of the Republic of Moldova to the accesss codes from range "1" by using prefix "0".
5. Accesss codes to public electronic communications networks and services assigned by the Agency shall not be transmitted to third parties.
6. Accesss codes for all providers of long-distance and international telephone services shall be assigned from number block "1010 - 1049", one code to every provider.

7. For the IP–telephony service access codes shall be assigned from number block “1600-1639” two codes to every provider.
8. Access codes to long-distance/international operator-assisted services shall be assigned from number block "1680 - 1699" up to three codes to every provider.
9. Technological codes for testing electronic communications networks shall be assigned to providers of public electronic communications networks from number block "1800 - 1899" in order to be used in the technological process of maintenance and repair of their own public telephone networks.
10. Access codes to providers of data transport networks and services (Dial-up Internet) shall be assigned from number block "1900 - 1949" - up to 2 codes to every provider.

5.2.2 Conditions for Assignment of Short Numbers from Range “1”

1. Short numbers for directory inquiry services shall be assigned to the providers of public electronic communications networks and services from the following number blocks: "1180 - 1181", "11820 - 11869" and "1187 - 1189".
 2. Short numbers for access to non-communications services: electric networks, thermal networks, natural gas networks, value-added networks ("Premium rate") shall be assigned from number block "1500 – 1539”.
 3. Numbers from short number block "1400 - 1499" shall be assigned for transportation services. Short numbers "14XX”, where X = 0...9, shall be assigned to providers of public fixed telephone services and networks, which subsequently shall be re-assigned, on contract basis, to economic entities providing transportation services (aeronautical companies, coach and railway stations, taxi companies, etc) for provision of information, ticket reservation, orders, etc.
 4. Payments for short numbers from “14XX” number block shall be paid onto the Agency account by the users of such numbers - economic entities providing transportation services – twice a year, upon receipt of bills, issued by the Agency, in installments equal to 1/2 of the payment established for one number.
 5. In the case of inability to pay according to the provisions of the previous section, the provider – license holder for the use of numbering resources or the holder of an assignment decision, upon the Agency’s requirement, shall disconnect the telephone lines used for the provision of services via short numbers from “14XX” number block.
 6. Where the contract for fixed telephony service provision is cancelled or the users of short numbers refuse to use such numbers, the provider of public electronic communications networks and services shall apply to the agency for withdrawal of the given numbers.
 7. In case of transfer of a short number from one provider of public electronic communications networks and services to another one, without change of user, the user of „14XX” numbers shall be re-connected simultaneously, in order to avoid eventual technical problems and interruptions in the user’s service provision. The bill shall be issued to the user taking into account the previous period of payment for the use of this number.
 8. When applying for a license for the use of numbering resources, the provider-applicant for short from number block „14XX” shall provide the information on company legal address, IDNO code, telephone and fax numbers of the user of short number.
 9. When a license holder for the use of numbering resources intends to transfer an assigned short number „14XX” from one user to another, with the latter’s consent, the license holder shall apply to the Agency for modification of license conditions. The application shall be accepted on condition that the user of short numbers has no debts for this particular short number.
 10. Access to the local „14XX” short numbers from other electronic communications networks shall be possible by using the following number formats: „14XX” – from fixed telephony networks in the same geographical zone, „0ZA(B) 14XX” – from cell mobile telephone networks, where „0” – national long-distance prefix, ZA(B) – NDC of the geographic zones from the Republic of Moldova. In Chisinau municipality access to „14XX” short numbers from cell mobile telephone networks shall also be possible by using the „14XX”.
- #### 5.3 Assignment of Numbering Resources from Ranges „8” and „9”

5.3.1 Conditions for Assignment of Numbering Resources from Ranges „8” and „9”

1. Number blocks from ranges „8” and „9” shall be assigned by the Agency to providers of public fixed telephony or transport data networks, in compliance with the general procedure of license issuance for the use of numbering resources and the corresponding assignment conditions for the requested numbers.
2. Numbering resources from ranges “8” and „9”, except number block „821XXXXX”, where: X = 0...9, shall be assigned in blocks of 100 or 1000 numbers. The next number block shall be assigned provided that at least 60% of the numbers from the previously assigned block have been used.
3. Accesss to numbers from ranges “8” and “9” from different networks and geographic zones of the Republic of Moldova shall be possible by using prefix “0”.

5.3.2 Conditions for Assignment of Numbering Resources from Range „8”

1. Numbers for "Freephone" service intended for public commercial and informational services shall be assigned by the Agency to providers of public fixed telephony networks from number block “800xxxxx”, where : x = 0...9, and upon exhaustion - from number block “801xxxxx” where : x = 0...9.
2. Numbers for "Freephone" service assigned by the Agency can be used by the provider for his own needs or re-assigned to be used by other enterprises or physical persons from the Republic of Moldova.
3. Numbers from "821XXXXX" block, where: x = 0...9, shall be assigned to providers of public data transport (Internet) networks and services to ensure the accesss to Dial Up Internet.
4. Numbers for shared-cost services shall be assigned by the Agency to providers of public fixed telephone services and networks from „808 xxxxx” number block, where: x = 0...9, and can be used for their own needs or re-assigned by the license holders to other legal persons from the Republic of Moldova.

5.3.3 Conditions for Assignment of Numbers from Range „9”

1. Numbers for accesss to value-added services ("Premium rate") shall be assigned by the Agency from number block "900xxxxx", where: x = 0...9, to providers of public fixed telephony networks.
2. Numbers for value-added services assigned by the Agency can be used by the electronic communications providers for provision of their own services or for directly assigning them to providers of content services.

6. ASSIGNMENT OF WITHDRAWN NUMBERING RESOURCES

1. Withdrawn numbering resources, can be subsequently assigned to another provider after 6 months, except short numbers from „14XX” block. Withdrawn numbering resources shall be re-assigned in compliance with the general procedure of license issuance for the use of numbering resources, as set forth in section 4.1.

7. RESERVATION OF NUMBERING RESOURCES

1. Free blocks of numbers intended for fixed and cell mobile telephony shall be subject to the reservation procedure. Numbering resources shall be reserved for as long as 1 year, for authorized providers of cell mobile and fixed telephony networks and services, who already hold previously assigned numbering resources of the same type.
2. The providers shall have the right to reserve a reasonable quantity of numbering resources, depending on the pace of their networks and services development.
3. The provider of public fixed and cell mobile networks and services who apply for number block reservation, shall undergo the general procedure of license issuance for the use of numbering resources, but in this case no license for the use of numbering resources shall be issued. If a decision is adopted to accept the reservation, the Administrator shall register the reserved numbering resources in the „ Numbering Resources Register”, under the remark: “Reserved”, shall indicate the provider’s name and address and period of reservation, subsequently informing the applicant in written form.
4. The payments for the following year shall be made by the date of expiry of a one-year term since the previous payment was made.

5. The reservation can be annulled in the following cases:

- a) at the request of the applicant;
- b) upon the applicant's failure to apply for a license for the use of the reserved numbering resources when the reservation timeframe expires.

8. ENSURING ACCESS TO NUMBERING RESOURCES

1. The providers of public electronic communications networks and services shall ensure, upon request, the access from/to own networks to the numbering resources of other providers, license holders for the use of numbering resources and have concluded direct or indirect interconnection agreements pursuant to the Regulation on Interconnection.

9. PAYMENTS FOR NUMBERING RESOURCES

1. Numbering resources shall be assigned/reserved by the Agency against a fee.
2. The fees for numbering resources assigned/reserved shall be set through Administrative Board Decisions.
3. Fees for numbering resources assigned for testing purposes shall be collected according to the tariffs in force, term and number of assigned resources.
4. The license holder for the use of numbering resources - the provider of electronic communications networks and/or services or, if appropriate, the user of short numbers – shall pay for numbering resources according to the tariffs in force the conditions established in these Regulations and Administrative Board Decisions.
5. The payments for numbering resources assigned by the Agency, except those for short numbers from number block "14XX", shall be made by the license holder on annual basis, onto the Agency current bank account. The payments for numbering resources shall be made pursuant to the conditions of assignment, set forth in Chapter 5.
6. In case of failure to pay to numbering resources, within 30 days from the date the bill was delivered to the license holder, the license for the use of numbering resources shall become invalid.
7. In case of withdrawal of inefficiently used or unused numbering resources, the payments shall not be reimbursable.

10. CONTROL ON USE OF NUMBERING RESOURCES

1. The Agency shall have the right to control the correctness of numbering resources use by the providers of public electronic communications networks and services in terms of compliance with the legislation, normative acts and regulations in force on numbering resource assignment.
2. The provider of public electronic communications networks and services, who are assigned with numbering resources, shall allow the access of the Agency representatives to exercise control over the use of numbering resources, pursuant to Art. 10 (1) of the Law on Electronic Communications.
3. The control over the use of numbering resources shall take place pursuant to the Regulations on Control Procedure in Electronic Communications.
4. In case of unauthorized use of numbering resources by providers of public electronic communications networks and services or other persons, the Agency shall have the right to apply sanctions under the legislation in force.

11. REPORT ON USE OF NUMBERING RESOURCES

1. Every year before January 31, the providers of public electronic communications networks and services shall submit a report on the use of numbering resources for the previous year, which shall contain:
 - a) numbering resources assigned to their subscribers;
 - b) details regarding numbers envisaged in their development plans, reservations for their subscribers.

12. ENSURING TRANSPARENCY

1. In order to ensure the transparency of primary assignment, reservation, withdrawal, renewal of numbering resources, the Agency shall make the following publicly available on its Web page:

- a) National Numbering Plan;
- b) the Regulations, other rules and conditions of primary assignment, reservation, withdrawal, renewal of numbering resources;
- c) reserved, assigned and free numbering resources.

13. FINAL PROVISIONS

1. Before the National Emergency Service "112" is implemented, the short numbers of access to emergency services, provided for in the old Numbering Plan, shall be maintained in the Republic of Moldova: fire brigade "901", police "902", medical service "903" and gas emergency service "904".
2. The access from public fixed telephony networks and from geographic zones of the Republic of Moldova to short codes and numbers from range "1" and number block „821XXXXX”, by using the prefix "0", shall be implemented before 31.12.2011. The providers of public fixed telephony networks shall make the necessary technical adjustments in their networks in order to comply with this provision.
3. Before 31.12.2011 the access from local fixed telephony networks to numbering resources from range "1" and to Internet (Dial-Up) services via numbers from "821XXXXX" block, within Chisinau area, shall be possible without dialing the prefix "0". Prefix "0" shall be dialed from other geographic zones of the Republic of Moldova to access the numbers from "821XXXXX" block.
4. Numbering resources assigned through previously issued license conditions and decisions of assignment shall be considered valid through their expiry date.
